


The Compost Co – Waiheke Island

Managed by the Waiheke Resource Trust, The Compost Co offers a food waste collection service to local restaurants and community groups. They also collect and processes single use compostable packaging from coffee shops and zero waste events. The Compost Co. is committed to reducing waste from landfill, and thus offer the only commercial compostable packaging service on the Island.



We Compost (Green Gorilla) – Auckland

We Compost provides a commercial collection service for compostable waste, including compostable food packaging. Their aim is to help organisations reduce their waste to landfill. Starting with one bin of coffee grinds on the back of a ute in 2010, they now divert around 10 tonnes of waste from landfill each week.

Soil Factory are an awesome bike-powered collection service based in Grey Lynn and servicing surrounding areas. Food and compostable packaging scraps are collected weekly and turned into beautiful rich compost at Kelmarna Gardens, their urban community farm.

Reclaim – Auckland & Wellington

Reclaim want to shift attitudes about waste. It should no longer be treated as rubbish and dismissed as worthless, it should be valued and reused as a future resource. Reclaim aim to ensure it is processed properly at dedicated recycling centres or composting facilities, rather than be buried in a landfill. Their goal is to offer tailored services to businesses so they can achieve waste reduction and sustainability goals.



Awapuni Resource Recovery Park Collection Service – Palmerston North

Palmerston North City Council (PNCC) accepts approved compostable packaging via its own food waste collection service and events recycling service (no drop offs sorry).



Kai to Compost – Wellington

Kai to Compost is a seven day a week, Wellington city based food waste collection service encouraging food waste producers like cafes, restaurants and supermarkets to minimise the environmental impact of food waste in our landfills. They accept most Ecoware compostable products (except PLA) as one of their compostable waste streams. After mixing food waste with green waste, Kai to Compost create top quality organic compost for Wellingtonians
